The story of this Barbaresco is fascinating! A **75 year old vineyard planted in 1936**, finally had to be eradicated in 2011 so the family decided to honour these plants by producing a **one time limited edition of Barbaresco** coming just from those old vines, their **last year of existence**. The name Mai Più translates to *Never Again*. Not only does it have a great story but it is an amazing wine!

Winery Information

Located in Treiso, the Nada Giuseppe property, now farmed by Enrico Nada, has two main cru sites. Casot is a south and southeast-facing plot with layers of blue and grey tufo soils between sand. Marcarini is its own cru, a cooler, southeast-facing site on the other side of the hill from Casot.

The estate comprises 9 hectares of vines, much of which was bought from the grandfather of Angelo Gaja. The Casot vineyards are adjacent to those that are used in Gaja's Barbaresco. The Nada Family has been making wine here since the 1960s. Farming at this estate is certified organic since 2017.
